We would like to begin by thanking you for your past and continued support of St Josephine Bakhita Secondary School in Gitare, Kenya. Generous donations from you and other contributors have enabled us to fund the building of a fully-fledged school where children from Gitare can now access high school level education.

During this past year, our vision to build a much needed kitchen was interrupted by the need for an updated and government mandated toilet block in order to have two physically separate facilities for boys and girls. With the toilet facilities in place, we are looking forward to restarting our kitchen construction project. Currently, meals are prepared and cooked in a temporary structure which is insufficient for our students.

According to the World Bank, school feeding programs in Sub-Saharan Africa are key to promoting class attendance, participation, improved learning, and higher student completion rates. In addition to preparing meals GITARE the students and staff, this kitchen will also be used to teach cooking skills to interested students on how to prep healthy meals for themselves and their families.
